A Short History

Clorox Dynasty

Since the beginning of time, the Clorox Dynasty has been a major power on Kleenari Prime, controlled by the iron fist of Pleluxonbub. He brought power and riches to the land, ensuring his subjects remained the most technologically advanced in the known universe. However, with his very sudden, mysterious passing, Pleluxonbub's son, Plezebub, was set to be the next Emperor.

On the last day of mourning, Plezebub was officially crowned the 2nd Emperor of Clorox. Not even two weeks later, his childhood friend and later Imperial Advisor, XEEP, accused him of money laundering. After a thorough trial, Plezebub was removed from the throne. With the Imperial seat left vulnerable, the people of Clorox elevated XEEP as the only viable successor.

Once crowned, XEEP's first order was to exile Plezebub and crush the fires of rebellion that had begun to arise among the former Emperor's loyal following. Over the next few years, the quality of life for the Cloroxians drastically declined, but no one would dare say it was brought about by the rule of the Right and Honorable Emperor XEEP.

B.O.B. Fuel Corp.

B.O.B Fuel Corporation is an interstellar starship propulsion company owned by the Bob family. Founded 180 solar rotations after the birth of the Clorox Dynasty, the Bob clan made their climb to the top using their pioneering Barium-based Oscillation Binary fuel technology ("B.O.B" for short). This complex formulation of rocket fuel creates an immense amount of power by forcing barium matter to flip between stable and unstable states.

The company is the primary fuel source for Kleenarian countries like Clorox, the Democratic Republic of Tidepodia, and Borax. This widespread dependence gave the Bob family vast economic influence over the planet. From this grip on the market, B.O.B Fuel Corp began an industrial revolution run by capitalist tycoons, ending Clorox's reputation of being the most technologically advanced society.

Democratic Republic of Tidepodia

Often viewed as the most industrialized country on Kleenari Prime, Tidepodia is known for its innovation, the most recent being a project developing robots capable of autonomous thought. Historically threatened by colonization by larger powers, it built a formidable military of 600,000 (the country's total population being only 800,000).

Though generally peaceful, the citizens of Tidepodia are very nationalistic and competitive. The Tidepodinese view the colonization of Earth as a chance to secure their

country's legacy. Despite this, their president, Lysin Tidepoddy, warned everyone during his most recent meeting with the senate, "If we do this and fail—or even succeed at high cost—there may not be enough of us left to be a nation."

Borax

Borax, the youngest country on the planet, was founded just 235 solar rotations after the birth of the Clorox Dynasty. As expected from a newer nation, Borax has yet to have any major conflicts with its neighboring countries. The state is governed by a five-member Federal Council, with seats rarely given to those outside of the families of the elite. Recently, Borax has been in the spotlight for being the country to first discover the new, potentially habitable planet: Earth.

The Discovery of Earth

The Discovery of Earth was a major historical event for the Kleenarians, all thanks to one Boraxan astronaut, Espalinet Nuevo. He found the planet while hurtling across the Milky Way due to a malfunction on his ship. According to data collected, it has the perfect conditions for life: clean air, liquid water, and most importantly, it doesn't rain glass. When the news reached home, all Kleenarians celebrated, elated at the chance of a better life.

Topic I: Claiming the Stars

For centuries, the Kleenarians have been forced to live underground, as the deadly molten glass storms and inhabitable surface of their planet made it impossible to even dream of fresh air. However, the discovery of Earth changes everything. If Kleenari Prime can somehow colonize this distant terrestrial planet and turn it into their ultimate paradise, they could finally leave the suffocating caverns of their homeworld. Such a monumental opportunity sparked a powerful global movement, demanding action and a chance of life where the sky is not a death sentence, but a horizon full of endless possibilities.

In response to this overwhelming uproar, the greatest minds of Kleenari Prime have been gathered together to explore the invasion of Earth. Chosen for their intellect and resources, they are tasked with shaping a plan for conquest. While some have jumped at the opportunity to bring their country incredible honor for generations to come, others have voiced their concerns that an invasion would bring massive casualties for both Kleenarians and innocent humans alike.

Now assembled at the most consequential conference in the last 5 centuries, the Chosen Ones must now decide the fate of all Kleenarians. Conquering Earth would require an unprecedented amount of resources, starships, and the ability to cross 64.5 light-years of hostile outer space. Not to mention what resistance they might encounter upon arrival. These intellectuals are tasked with forging one unified invasion plan for the planet to act on as a whole, considering every factor at stake. Faced with such impossible stakes, how can such a challenging undertaking be organized, and who will rise to command the campaign that could redefine the future of Kleenari Prime?

Guiding questions:

1. Should the invasion of Earth even take place, given the potential consequences?
2. Who is best suited to lead a campaign of this scale, and on what grounds should that leadership be chosen?
3. What kind of military force, technological resources, and strategic planning would be required to attempt a successful colonization of Earth?

Topic II: The Winner Takes it All

Armed with only their plan, fleets and wits, the Chosen Ones are now tasked with leading their men into deep space. They must travel 64.5 light-years across the known universe, dodging dangerous threats and navigating their way through deadly, uncharted paths. The journey will test their coordination, manpower, resources and technology, especially as conditions change in unpredictable ways. Tension within the group will inevitably grow, and maintaining a consistent, unified goal will become increasingly difficult.

Even if they survive the trip, their hardships will not end there. Despite reaching Earth, the group has long had conflicting opinions on how to deal with the humans, and now the time has finally come. Will they attempt peaceful colonization, or is violence the only option?

Beyond that choice lies another challenge. Earth is a vast planet, with large stretches of land now free for the taking. The Chosen Ones must then decide who will get a piece of the pie, and how big a slice they'll take. Additionally, the new world will require law and order, but how will this be determined? Will power be shared, contested, or seized outright?

These decisions will not only test their loyalty to their people but also their trust in one another. The choices of the Chosen Ones will not just shape their new future on Earth, but they also will decide who holds the power, and who must kneel before it.

Guiding questions:

1. What kind of approach should be taken towards humanity? Peaceful coexistence, submission or extinction?
2. By what principles should Earth's territory and resources be divided and controlled?
3. How should power and authority be established among the Chosen Ones upon reaching Earth?

Committee Mechanics

Kleenex

The global currency of Kleenari Prime is valued at one Canadian dollar. Delegates may spend kleenex to aid in their campaigns by sending notes to backrooms. Amounts and expenses must be specified, justified, and reasonable.

Resources

Each delegate will be given a base set of resources, which may be accessed through notes to crisis. To upgrade resources, delegates must spend kleenex or collaborate with other delegates to arrange resource-sharing agreements (must be approved by backrooms). Types of resources include: weapon technology, raw materials found on Kleenari Prime, communication systems, fuel reserves, data about Earth, navigational systems, and starship construction.

Militia

The military power of a campaign will influence the likelihood of a successful invasion of Earth. Military force can be boosted through kleenex or alliances with other delegates. Militia encompasses: man power, military readiness, star fleet size and amount of weaponry.

Starship Driving License

All invasion directives must include at least one delegate with a valid starship driving license, as Kleenarian law mandates that all fleets must be led from the flagship by a certified commander.

Divine Oversight

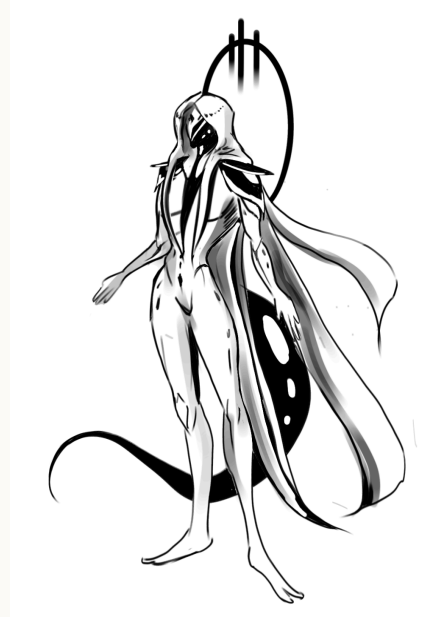
Limited to Overseers, this power grants the ability to envision the near future. However, the Divine Oversight does not guarantee that all or any paths given are correct. After the paths are given, no further extensions shall be granted. To talk to the spirits of the Galaxy, the Overseer must risk their life and inhale an epoxy resin vapor through written crisis notes. This power may only be used twice every committee session.

Keep | Current Emperor of The Clorox Dynasty

{Pronounced: Z-ee-puh}

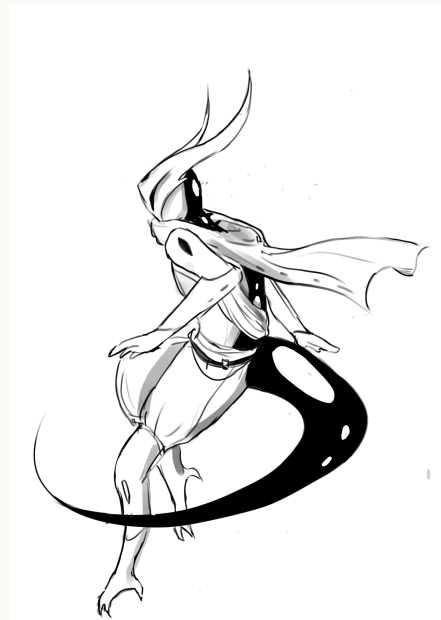

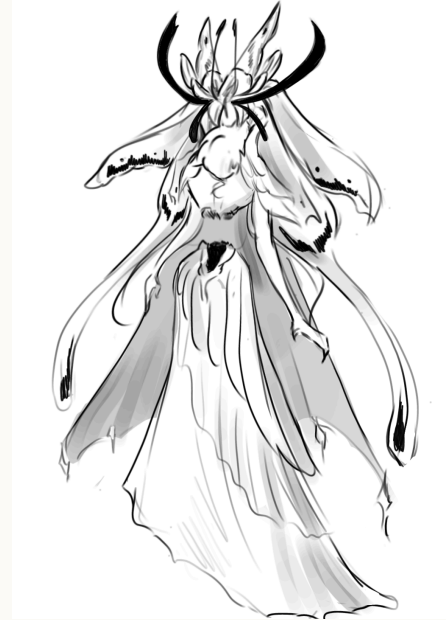

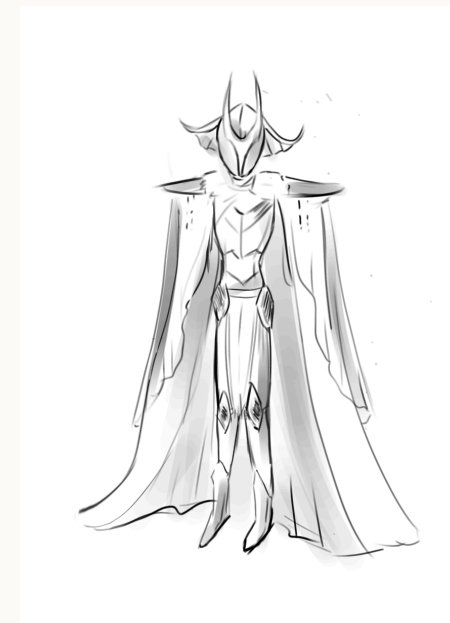
Farmer Bob | CEO of BOB Fuel Corp.

{Pronounced: Felix Moo-owck}

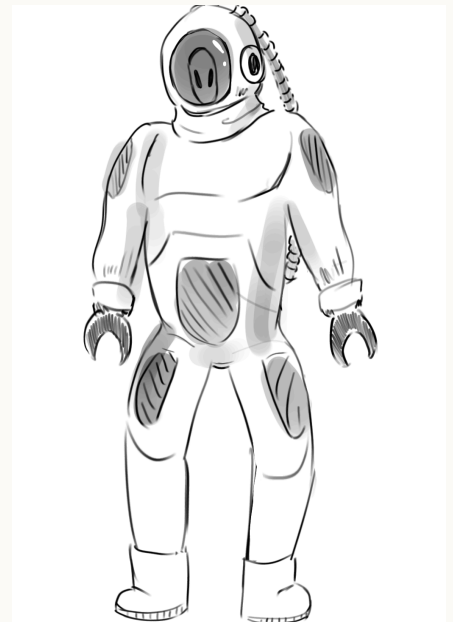

Adam n'Eve | All-knower of Earth

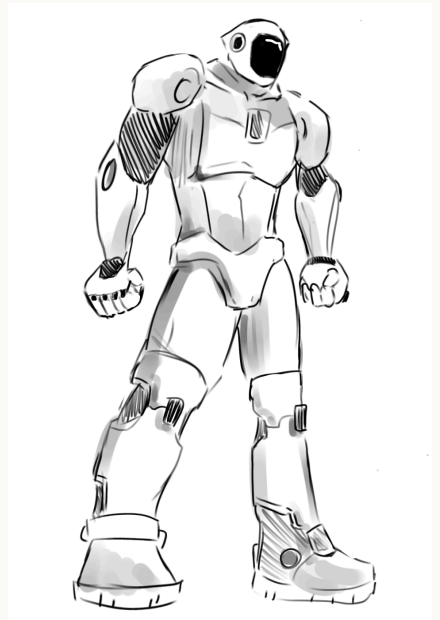
{Pronounced: Adam an Ee-vuh}
